



INCM joins the homage made to the combatants of East-Timor

The Portuguese Mint and Official Printing Office (INCM) joins the homage that the Government of East-Timor shall be making to the combatants of the East Timor Revolutionary Armed Front for their dedication and braveness during their fight for the independence by donating a metal signet with the coat of arms of the Democratic Republic of East-Timor plus 236 certificates of honour.

The certificates, produced and personalized by the INCM shall be offered by the Government of East-Timor during the first official ceremony for the demobilisation and acknowledgement of those combatants, within the scope of the celebrations of the 20th of August, the National day of the FALINTIL. This donation is the result of the protocol signed on the 18th of July with the Ministry of Social Solidarity of the Democratic Republic of East-Timor, and for this purpose had the support of the Portuguese authorities through the embassy in Dili.

The Portuguese Mint and Official Printing Office, through the offer of the above mentioned certificates, besides associating itself to the official ceremonies and to the homage to be offered by the Government of East-Timor, is also contributing to strengthen the historical and cultural ties, and the cooperation between Portugal and the Democratic Republic of East-Timor.
